Roverway 2024 is taking place in Norway from July 22nd to August 1st, 2024. Guides and Scouts of Norway, WAGGGS and WOSM are working hard together to deliver a relevant and exciting internationalevent to Rovers and Rangers from all over Europe.

In order to contribute to the success of the event and at the same time seize the opportunity to provide a meaningful learning experience to young adult leaders, WAGGGS is planning several activities. **Please find a detailed description of the activities at the end of this document.**

  - **envisaged requirements: able to communicate in English, experience in delivering educational activities, open attitude to a diverse and international environment, at least 18 years of age by October 2023. We commit to select at least one candidate.**
- ✓ **Ensure participants member of your MO provide all supporting documentation for their travel and expenses. We will duly inform them on requirements.**
- ✓ **Provide participants the opportunity to share their learning and experience once back home**



### **Financial support for selected participants**

Europe Region WAGGGS is committed to support financially as much as possible the participation of young leaders.

- Participants coming from an MO part of the Europe Region WAGGGS might have to pay a small financial contribution.
  - o ERW is aware that there are MOs part of the Europe Region that unfortunately are not eligible under this grant. **ERW is committed to find other sources of funding to support selected participants coming from these MOs**
  - o Participants coming from an eligible country, but that will not be part of this project will be welcome – but they might have to cover the most of the expenses
- Participants coming from an MO that is not part of the Europe Region WAGGGS (if any) will have to cover the difference between the grant allocation for their participation, and the real costs

### **Description and objectives of the activities**

The activities described below have two purposes:

- Deliver a high quality international non-formal educational experience to Rovers and Rangers coming to Roverway2024
- Provide a meaningful international non-formal learning experience to young volunteers, increasing their understanding of WAGGGS; the Girl Guiding and Girl Guiding Learning framework and non-formal educational methods, how it applies to young adults in the R&R age group, enhance facilitation skills in a very diverse environment and build international friendship and Network

### **Background Information**

The Europe Region WAGGGS will offer educational activities to Rovers and Rangers from all over Europe taking part in the Roverway. To do so we will recruit leaders (facilitators) with experience in working with Rovers and Rangers to deliver educational activities at the central camp. WAGGGS facilitators at Roverway should be able to deliver workshops in an engaging, fun and inclusive way, being aware of diversity issue at theoretical and practical level. They should know the Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting Educational Methods and be able to apply it to the Rovers and Rangers age group.

In order to increase WAGGGS capacity to deliver such activities, as well as to provide a meaningful learning experience to young volunteers the following activities will be delivered to selected facilitators:

### **Preparation**

- Call for facilitators (from July 2023 to October 2023)
- Selection of facilitators – November 2023
- Coordinated long distance work
- 5 days learning event to increase facilitators understanding of the GGGs Learning Framework and Educational Methods, R&R age group, ability to design learning activities for a diverse target group, sharing good practices (April/May 2024)

For interested MOs: sharing of learning and discussion within the programme commission, and/or the R&R commission to see what can be transferable from the learning experience of participants to the MO

### **Learning by Doing – activities at Roverway 2024**

From the July 22nd to August 1st, 2024

- 5 days at Roverway 2024, focused on delivering of activities to R&R
- During this experience, there will be on-going support for workshop facilitators, so they can build up on the experience

### **Financial contribution**

#### **For MOs that are part of the Europe Region WAGGGS, and are eligible for this grant application.**

Participants coming from a Member Organisation will have facilitators travel & accommodation costs fully covered.

#### **For MOs that are part of the Europe Region WAGGGS, and are not eligible for this grant application.**

We regret your MO is not part of the eligible countries under this grant. Unfortunately at the moment we have not been able to identify a suitable grant that covers all MOs part of the ERW with priorities aligned with this project.

Nonetheless your members will be able to apply to the call for facilitators for Roverway 2024 that will be sent out this coming summer, and be part of this project. The ERW is committed to keep the financial contribution as low as possible.

Travel distances will be calculated by WAGGGS using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission. The KM calculation refers to a one-way travel from their place of residence to the venue of the activity. If no specific place of residence is indicated, WAGGGS will take the capital city as departure point.
